Thousands of casual workers will immediately get an <u>average wage</u> <u>increase of 9.5 per cent</u>.

Casuals will no longer be stuck on a lower wage grid and will be able to reach the top Customer Service Representative (CSR) wage.

As well, the full-time CSRs who aren't at the top of the grid will immediately get an **average wage increase of 7.7 per cent**.

This award is the result of members taking a stand to demand fair treatment for all workers, and sets an important precedent for precarious workers across Ontario.
